Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Important Procedures as We Prepare for Extreme Weather Conditions

This afternoon, the Premier and the Department of Education announced that schools will be open tomorrow (Wednesday), with decisions reviewed daily.

With heavy rainfall and strong winds expected across Queensland, we understand that families may face different challenges based on their location. At this stage, students who can safely attend school are encouraged to do so. However, Parents and Caregivers should make their own judgments on whether it is safe to send their students to school. It is possible, for example, for it to be safe or appropriate for the College to open but unsafe or inappropriate for particular students to attend because of individual circumstances. Families are to follow normal absentee processes via the College App/ Portal.

As we prepare for Cyclone Alfred's impacts in the coming days, we want to ensure all Parents and Caregivers are aware of the College's procedures for severe weather, including possible closures or access issues due to flooding or strong winds. The well-being and safety of our students and staff remain our highest priority.
