Eligibility and Selection Criteria

At the Principal's discretion, this scholarship will be available to students entering Year 10 and, subject to the terms and conditions that apply, continue into Year 11 and Year 12, who are motivated to complete Year 12 and who have an interest in tertiary study.

This special Scholarship is offered to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students.

Applicants will be chosen according to the following selection criteria:

- a) Current academic progress and proven application to study
- b) Potential to thrive in and engage in the Lourdes Hill College community, including, but not limited to, Spirituality days, Sports days, Co-curricular activities, Mass, Mirragin Program
- c) Leadership qualities
- d) Co-curricular involvement
- e) Attendance history
- f) Australian Citizen
- g) Involvement in Culture

The Aunty Joan Hendriks Scholarship is awarded on merit and through an interview and application process overseen by the Principal or her delegate.

How to Apply

Applications for open in July for students in Year 9 and will be offered by 30 October each year if awarded.

Any student who wishes to apply for an Aunty Joan Hendriks Scholarship at Lourdes Hill College must complete the following form and provide a 250-word statement on how they would contribute to the College and Mirragin Program, along with copies of their Year 5, 7 and 9 NAPLAN results and three most recent school reports.
